



Terms and Conditions

The NZSSPC organisation reserves the right to be able to disqualify and remove any entry that does not comply with the requirements below, even after it is submitted through the competition. By entering the competition, the participant acknowledges that:

1. They are the sole owner and creator of each entry
2. Their entry does not contain personally identifiable information about them or any other people
3. Their entry does not contain any infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, libellous, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, scandalous, inflammatory, pornographic or profane content
4. Their entry does not contain any material that could constitute or encourage conduct which would be considered a criminal offense, give rise to civil liability, or otherwise violate any law
5. Their entry does not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, contract rights, or any other intellectual property rights of any third person or entity, or violate any person's rights of privacy or publicity
6. They confirm that any person depicted in their entry has granted permission to be portrayed as shown. Any costumes, props or other materials used must be rented or borrowed with the permission of the owner, and all other relevant permissions must have been obtained.
7. If your entry is judged to be within the top 18 entries of the competition, you agree that the NZSSPC may [in conjunction with Bayleys] offer one hard copy print of your entry via an online auction. NZSSPC will apply half the proceeds of any sale to the cost of sustaining the NZSSPC and the other half to the Make a Wish Foundation. We will identify you as the creator of the image and your entry will be displayed online for the auction along with your name, age and school.



If you are under 16, you have your parent or legal guardian's consent to participate in this competition. If NZSSPC does not receive a valid signed parental or legal guardian consent form from any winner, the NZSSPC will be entitled to select an alternative winner.

The NZSSPC will be running a People's Choice Award where people are allowed to vote for their favourite photograph amongst the shortlisted photographs. If there is sufficient evidence to suggest malpractice or manipulation of the voting, then the NZSSPC organisation and the right to remove the relevant entry or entries and, if necessary, award the prize to a different contestant.

The NZSSPC organisation recognizes that the participant is the author of the image and will relate full ownership of the copyright in each entry. However all entrants must understand that any image submitted to the competition may be used by the NZSSPC and its Event Partners for marketing and promotional purposes of the participant themselves and the event only which may include judging the competition, displaying photos on the NZSSPC website and more. The participant acknowledges and grants the NZSSPC a non-exclusive, irrevocable license in each entry to use for five years in all media for the promotion of the participant themselves or the event.

The participant acknowledges that it is their responsibility for protecting any entry against image misuse by any third party, for example, but not limited to the insertion of a watermark. the NZSSPC organisation and its Event Partners assume no responsibility and are not liable for any image misuse.

By entering the competition, you agree and acknowledge that the NZSSPC organisation are allowed to receive your registration data. Any personal information given to the NZSSPC organisation will not be given to third parties and only used for organisational purposes.
